A demonstration by our shearer on the art of shearing a sheep is conducted in the most unique shearing shed in Australia - Tobruk Sheep Station has the only shearing shed with a grandstand that can accommodate 200 people. The history of shearing and life of the shearer is explained in an both and educational and entertaining manner. Members of audience often have the opportunity to try their hand at shearing a sheep where the participants work with the experienced shearer under strict guidance.

The wool classing commences the business end of shearing, where the financial viability of the wool clip rests. The fleece is skirted, by removing inferior pieces of wool, then classed by the wool classer and stored in selected wool bins. Our experienced stockmen take the audience through this process in a straightforward, simple, entertaining and comical manner.
