Used by the stockmen to assist in the mustering process, the cracking of a whip is not as easy as it looks. The cracking of the whip is achieved by the “cracker” breaking the sound barrier. Our experienced stockmen will entertain you with their amazing whip tricks including the Snake-cutter, the “Tiger Woods”, the Steam Train and many others.

A demonstration of the Aboriginal technique of boomerang throwing follows the whip cracking demonstration. Originally used as a hunting weapon, the boomerang at Tobruk is demonstrated and used as a recreational device only!
